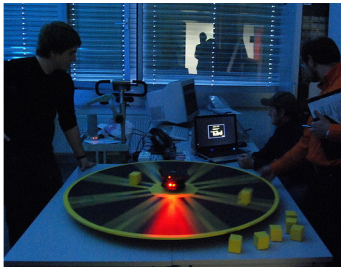


## Showcase your Business Subject to Employees of Tomorrow!



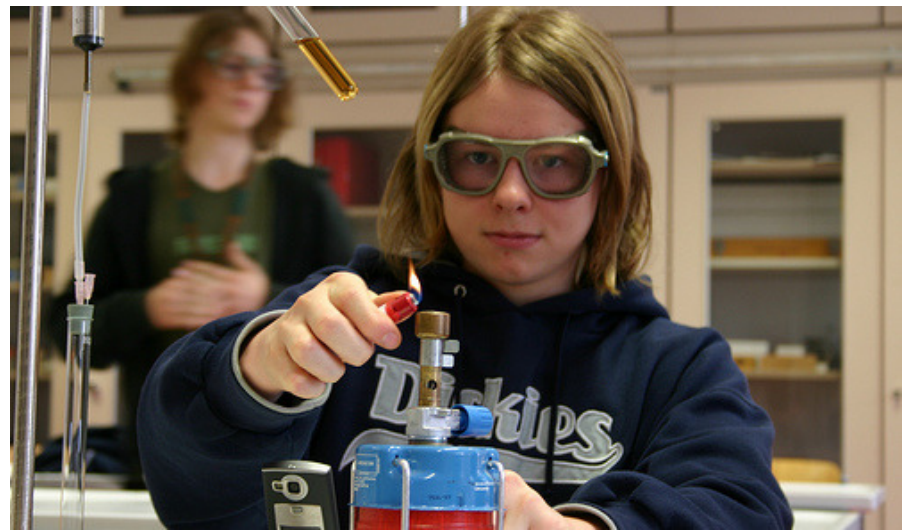
A collaboration with European Schoolnet

INSPIRE (Innovative Science Pedagogy in Research and Education) is a project of the European Commission in frame of Lifelong Learning Program.
