Five more risk profiles are expected to be added by Drive Sustainability in 2023.

Raw Materials Outlook has been developed by the Drive Sustainability's Raw Materials Working Group, in collaboration with <u>Levin Sources</u>, as a contribution to the achievement of **Responsible Sourcing**, through risk identification and assessment, as well as under collective leverage and actions.

The platform also supports Drive Sustainability's **Original Equipment Manufacturers** (OEMs) with valuable insights on how to improve the efficacy of their risk and impact management strategies and processes.
