CONTEXT

On July 14, 2021, the European Commission adopted the so-called "Fit for 55": a package of proposals to make the European Union's (EU) climate, energy, land use, transport, and taxation policies fit for reducing net greenhouse gas emissions by at least 55% by 2030. To transit to a low-carbon, resilient, and resource-efficient economy, the EU is reinforcing its legislative framework to push for more transparency and sustainability in business practices. The EU Taxonomy Regulation, a classification system for sustainable investment, includes technical screening criteria that companies and investors will use to measure the performance of economic activities on environmental sustainability.

As the new Taxonomy framework will be implemented as of January 2022, it is of utmost importance that you have a deep understanding of how this will translate into practice. Your company is required to disclose its first **Taxonomy Report in 2022**. In addition to the Taxonomy Regulation, the European Commission has revised the Non-Financial Reporting Directive (NFRD) into the **Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD)**. The revised directive will expand in scope and introduce new sustainability reporting requirements for companies. Your company will have to align with the new directive by disclosing an **Integrated Report from 2024** onwards. Therefore, this Atelier will prepare you and your company for the upcoming reporting alignment processes.

ABOUT THE ATELIER

1. Aim of the series:

The Atelier is a new learning format that brings together corporate members of CSR Europe to discuss their approaches, challenges faced, as well as identify good and innovative practices. Each Atelier will have practical deliverables which will encourage the companies' representatives to develop and implement company-specific improvement plans.

This is an **exclusive activity** especially planned for CSR Europe's corporate only. The event is held under **Chatham House Rules**.

For 2021, CSR Europe Markets' Atelier series is structured in three events. CSR Europe methodologies & Learnings from frontrunners

Driven by **experts and frontrunner companies**, the Atelier 2 on the 16th of September 2021 will provide participants with an **overview and specifics of the Taxonomy**, along with a **practical understanding of its usability and application**. You will hear from frontrunner companies on how they start preparing for the Taxonomy by sharing *useful practices and challenges*. The event will include an **interactive exercise on Taxonomy eligibility, according to the Delegated Act on Climate Mitigation** in which <u>active participation</u> will be required. The exercise will provide participants with a better *understanding of the usability of the Taxonomy and how to align it with their companies' activities*.

Lastly, **CSR Europe** will provide you with the chance to get acquainted with an exclusive Corporate Transparency Checklist that covers 5 main EU regulations: *CSRD*, *Sustainable Corporate Governance*, and *Due Diligence*, *CBCR*, and *Taxonomy*. The aim will be for participants to get acquainted with the Checklist and take it as homework. Participants can complete the Checklist, with the support of CSR Europe, and share it back with us before Atelier 3.

The <u>Atelier 3</u> will take place on <u>December 9th</u>, **2021** and *will be a continuation of the work of Atelier 2*. This final Atelier aims to improve companies' understanding of the Taxonomy and CSRD and thus prepare for the upcoming reporting cycles. More focus will be given to the Taxonomy with further enhanced training to better prepare participants for 2022. CSR Europe will share common challenges between participants and provide useful practices to address them.
