CONTEXT

COVID-19. Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Energy and cost-of-living crisis. Impacts of climate change. Upskilling imperative for a green and digital economy. Challenges to the social dimension of the EU's sustainability agenda abound. With the 2024 European elections on the horizon, new priorities for the 2024-2029 period are at stake, creating opportunities for policymakers to engage with companies as allies in shaping together a Social Green Deal.

ABOUT THE EVENT

On 14th November, <u>CSR Europe</u> is convening in Brussels representatives of its <u>Leadership Hubs' member companies</u>, <u>high-level representatives of the European Commission</u> - including <u>Thierry Breton</u>, <u>Commissioner for Internal Market</u> - for the <u>second Sustainability Leadership Salon</u>. The event, co-organised with <u>Globascan</u> and hosted by <u>Solvay</u>, builds upon the <u>learnings of the previous Salon</u> to further advance on development of a <u>Business Manifesto for a Social Green Deal 2024-2029</u>.

Amidst the ongoing avalanche of sustainability policy proposals and institutional reforms, participants will address the following questions:

- How can the European Green Deal grow into a European Social Green Deal?
- How can the European Union and its policymakers engage with committed enterprises as allies to build a
 more integrated and competitive sustainability playing field that makes the EU Green Deal feasible for
 businesses, including SMEs?
- Are EU leaders ready to roll out a Marshall plan to finance business transformation and facilitate impactful alliances?

DELIVERABLE

Following the Salon, CSR Europe and its Leadership Hubs' representatives will finalize the Business Manifesto for a Social Green Deal 2024-2029. The policy paper will be presented to the outgoing European Commission President, Ursula Von Der Leyen, as well as to the representatives of the Spanish and Belgian EU Presidencies of the Council of the EU. After the European elections of June 2024, CSR Europe will also share the Manifesto with the newly elected EU leaders.
