

CONTEXT

Following the [1st NPO Meeting](#), CSR Europe launched a Call to Action to scale up mutual collaboration for the development of practical projects based on common sustainability priorities. As a result, **four top sustainability topics have been identified** as a priority for the National Partner Organisations in 2023:

- **Diversity & Inclusion**
- **Sustainability Reporting**
- **Upskilling & Reskilling**
- **Supply chain sustainability**

ABOUT THE EVENT

CSR Europe is pleased to welcome its National Partner Organisations (NPOs) to the **2023 NPO Bootcamp to work together on the development of a common project on the topics of:**

- **Upskilling & Reskilling** – led by [Fondazione Sodalitas](#) and [Impronta Etica](#)
- **Diversity & Inclusion** – led by [RBF Poland](#)

Since no leader was found for the topics of sustainability reporting and supply chain sustainability, these two will not be part of the event.

At the Bootcamp, CSR Europe will divide the NPOs into two groups based on their preference to work on upskilling & reskilling or diversity & inclusion. Throughout the day, each group will work to define:

- **Scope of the project & timeline** – What challenges will the project address? What timeline should it follow?
- **Potential consortium** – What actors should be involved? What would be their role?
- **Business model** – How can the project be funded?

EXPECTED OUTCOME

The NPOs' ideas and expertise should lead to the **co-creation of 2 draft proposals outlining the format, content, timeline, and business model of the future projects**. The proposals - pitch decks - will then be presented to the CSR Europe Board for feedback. The 2 NPO-led projects should then be kicked off in 2024.
