The Sustainability Event of the Year in Europe...

After the pandemic and amid the outbreak of the war in Ukraine, the world needs to accelerate the journey towards **climate neutrality** and the adoption of an **inclusive approach** to the green and digital transition.

The scale and magnitude of the effort ahead require not only individual commitments to net-zero but also **collaborative action from all stakeholders.**

For this reason, ahead of the 27th United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP27) in Egypt, CSR Europe convened sustainability leaders worldwide at <u>the European SDG</u> <u>Summit 2022: Together for an Inclusive Green</u> <u>Deal</u>, on 10-12 October 2022.

Over the course of 3 days, CSR Europe welcomed +4.500 attendees; +150 C-level speakers from the European Institutions, businesses, governments, financial institutions, academia, and civil society organisations; 50 organisations of CSR Europe's wide network and delivered +30 hours of engaging content to build a European Social and Green Deal.

Highlight of the event was the release of 8 business tools to support companies' journey towards an inclusive green and digital transition.



CSR Europe partnered up with the "Running Out of Time" Climate Relay to carry a powerful message about climate action from vouna people to world's leaders at COP27:

This is the longest non-stop relay ever attempted across 18 countries, from Glasgow (COP26) to Sharm-el-Sheik in Egypt (COP27).

On 11 October, during the European SDG Summit, the CSR Europe team joined the run from the Arcades du Cinquantenaire to Pont Du Buda in Brussels, carrying the baton with the message.


