Incubate collaborative action towards the SDGs through the creation of multi-stakeholder partnerships, by leveraging CSR Europe's Network of 42 National Partner Organisations (NPOs) reaching over 11,000 companies and key stakeholders in 31 countries across Europe. Members of CSR Europe prepare topics to be included in our incubator. For the moment four topics have been elaborated.



The Challenge

Cities and urban areas across Europe and the World are facing a range of serious challenges, such as traffic congestion, greenhouse gas emissions, air and noise pollution, health issues, safety risks and security threats. Fundamental changes are needed, but the public sector has limited means to achieve these goals. Private interests, however, could simultaneously drive and benefit from the transition to sustainable mobility systems. To encourage private-public sector cooperation for sustainable mobility, the SDG Incubator encourages the exploration of opportunities for collective action.

The Challenge

A frictionless freight logistics sector is a key enabler for the free flow of goods through the EU. However, the sector faces several challenges related to the continuous rise in costs, negative environmental externalities and a shortage of qualified staff. These issues might lead to inefficiencies in the sector. Rethinking of company processes, business models, working conditions and legal frameworks are key factors to enhance the sustainability of logistics. To this aim, the SDG Incubator encourages the exploration of opportunities for collective action to enhance sustainability in the freight logistics supply chain.
