Transparency on tax payments in countries of operation is an emerging topic affecting all industries in the private sector, with both EU legislation and intergovernmental voluntary measures (e.g. OECD Base Erosion and Profit Shifting project – BEPS) soon to be voted and published. The financial industry in Europe already has an obligation to report on tax payments and other related information on a country-by-country basis, but questions remain on the scope, the public nature, the form and usefulness of disclosure of future measures affecting all industries.
